EDUNINE 2019 (III IEEE World Engineering Education Conference) will be held in Lima, Peru, the *City of Kings* that is located on the central coast of the Pacific Ocean in South America, from **March 17 to 20, 2019**, at the headquarters of the **Universidad del Pacífico**, located in the **Jesús María District of Lima, Peru**.

The theme of this edition is **Modern Educational Paradigms for Computer and Engineering Careers**. The main objective is to provide innovative solutions to the challenges currently facing Engineering and Computer Education in order to contribute to the improvement of the educational quality.

EDUNINE will be held every year in a different Latin American city. It is an annual conference of the **IEEE Education Society** organized jointly with **COPEC** for **Region 9 (Latin America)**. This conference is part of the renowned list of regional conferences of this Society that are: *FIE* (Region 1-7), *EDUCON* (Region 8), *EDUNINE* (Region 9) and *TALE* (Region 10).

Prospective authors are invited to submit original papers in one of the Submission types: **Full Paper (6 pages)** or **Work-in-Progress Paper (4 pages)**. We are especially interested in papers that explore the following areas: *classroom experiences, teaching techniques, curricular initiatives, pedagogical tools or educational research projects*. Papers should address one or more of the **Thematic Streams**. Note that an **Abstract Submission** (maximum **150 words**) is required for all papers.

All **papers** and **abstracts** must be *written* in **English** which is the official language of the Conference in order to address a wider audience. The papers will be evaluated by peers based on originality, technical and/or research content/depth, correctness, relevance to conference, contributions, and readability.

Papers that are *accepted* will be *submitted for publishing* in **IEEE Xplore® digital library** providing at least one author completes registration and presents the work at the Conference. The languages for the *oral presentations* are **English** and also **Portuguese** and **Spanish**, corresponding to the most spoken languages in the Latin American region. There will be no poster sessions.
